1. This tournament is open to ALL **USBC** members and is **USBC** certified.
2. Entrants must use the highest certified league average, or composite average of 21 games or more from the 2022-2023 season as shown on bowl.com, including summer leagues. If no 2022-2023 average, they can use the highest current certified league average with 21 games or more. If using the current league average, a copy of the bowler's individual average page or current standing sheet must accompany the entry form. League members with no established average will be given a 220 average. If any average is from a Sport League (also known as Tough Shot and PBA Experience), Challenge, or established on sport patterns, tough shots, international patterns, whether the league is certified or not, it must be reported and will be adjusted as per the USBC conversion chart. Use of this average for entry may be denied.
3. If you bowl a strike on the first ball you get the strike, if you get a nine count on your first ball you get a strike. If you get an eight count or less on your first ball, you will bowl your second ball.
4. All games are bowled on the same lanes.
5. Winners will be determined by adding the best three games out of the four games bowled for the series.
6. A bowler may enter twice, but only cash once (this does not affect the 300 Game Jackpot or the **TOURNAMENT BONUS**)
7. Youth bowlers will have all prize winnings deposited into their SMART account.
8. Adults can bowl with the youth if desired. Please mark the entry form.
9. There will be three divisions for adults: under 161 avg; 161-190; 191 and above. The youth will have two divisions: under 151 avg and 151 avg and above.
10. All **USBC** tournament rules will apply.
11. Awards will be given out in a 1 to 7 ratio.
12. Any bowler arriving late will be allowed to bowl and their score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled on their scheduled pair of lanes.
13. Mulligans and Super-Mulligans may be used to re-bowl a frame. If after you bowl your first ball and you would like to erase your score, contact an official to erase it and re-bowl the frame (frames 1-9). A super-mulligan can be used for the 1st ball, tenth frame only. Each bowler is allowed two mulligans and two super-mulligans per series, but can only use one per game. \$5 per mulligan and \$10 per super-mulligan is paid at the time the mulligan is used.
14. 300 Game Jackpot. A \$10 entry fee must be paid before bowling. Each game bowled earns a share of the Jackpot. The more 300's you bowl the more shares you win. If \$1000 is collected in a squad and eight 300's are bowled that squad, each share is worth \$125. All games count for the Jackpot.
15. Credit card payments are accepted, and a 5% fee will be added on.
16. The Mystery Doubles pot is a handicap pot based on 100% of 220.
