SWC Youth Doubles Tournament Rules 2023

IT IS EACH BOWLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO READ, UNDERSTAND AND ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING RULES

Athletes under the age of 18 are under the governance of their parent/guardian for the duration of the event. All athletes shall abide by the rules and conditions for the 2023 Youth Doubles Tournament. Athletes/parents/Guardians release the sponsoring organizations, and each of them, and their respective officers, members, employees, agents, successors and assigns, from any and all liability for any injury to person or damage to or loss of property which an athlete may sustain, or which a parent/guardian may sustain as a result thereof or directly, during or as result of an athlete's participation in the tournament

- 1. This tournament is certified by Suburban Windy City USBC and governed by the rules of USBC
- 2. All bowlers must be currently bowling in a USBC league certified by Suburban Windy USBC and must present their 2023-24 USBC membership card at check in. If card is not yet received, proof that one has been applied for must be presented at check in.
- 3. Divisions will be as follows for all double pairs: U12, U15 and U18 The oldest bowler determines the final age division
- 4. Entrant shall use highest 2022-2023 sanctioned league average (21 game minimum). If bowler does not have a 21-game sanctioned average for 2022-23 the entrant shall use highest sanctioned 2023-2024 league average as of and including Saturday, October 7th, 2023 with a minimum of 12 games. A copy of bowler's league sheet must accompany the application showing bowlers total pins and games with average. If neither 2022-23 or 2023-24 average can be provided, the bowler will enter as scratch.
- 5. Handicap will be 100% of 440 total for both bowlers with 3 games being bowled
- 6. In case of disability/injury after a game has started, unfinished frames/games will be scored with a zero.
- 7. Pre-Paid late bowlers will be allowed to bowl but starting at the current frame and receiving zero for the frames missed.
- 8. Walk ins permitted as space allows and will be charged an additional \$5 late entry fee.
- 9. Only competitors and tournament officials shall be allowed in the settee area during practice and competition. No coaching of bowlers will be allowed during tournament competition.
- 10. Bowlers are not permitted to eat or drink in the player's area while participating in the tournament. There will be no alcoholic beverages consumed at the lanes during the competition.
- 11. The use of any electronic device in the bowler's area is prohibited during competition
- 12. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament manager immediately. All score corrections must be made or approved by a tournament official.
- 13. Any appeal or protest shall, in all cases, be made in writing to the tournament manager and shall be submitted no later than 24 hours after the game has been bowled. Entrant must state grounds for the appeal or protest and all pertinent information. The action of the tournament officials shall be final.

DRESS CODE (STRICTLY ENFORCED):

Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use good judgement when selecting attire. worn tattered or faded clothing is not considered suitable.

The following attire is PROHIBITED: Hats, shorts, CLOTHING ADVERTISING TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, OBSCENE GESTURES OR OBSCENE PICTURES IS PROHIBITED. Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament manager or designee. Decisions will be final. Questions about appropriate attire may be directed to the SWC Office or tournament management on site.
