## IT IS EACH BOWLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO READ, UNDERSTAND AND ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING RULES

Athletes under the age of 18 must have a parent/guardian present for the duration of the event. All athletes shall abide by the rules and conditions for the 2024 Adult/Youth Tournament. Athletes/parents/Guardians release the sponsoring organizations, and each of them, and their respective officers, members, employees, agents, successors and assigns, from any and all liability for any injury to person or damage to or loss of property which an athlete may sustain, or which a parent/guardian may sustain as a result thereof or directly, during or as result of an athlete's participation in the tournament.

- 1. This tournament is certified by Suburban Windy City USBC and governed by the rules of USBC
- 2. Open to all youth bowlers currently in a Suburban Windy City Youth league. Adult bowlers are not required to be certified but will follow rule 5 to determine handicap
- 3. Divisions will be as follows for all double pairs: U12, U15 and U18.
- 4. Handicap will be 95% of 440 total for both bowlers with 3 games being bowled
- 5. Youth bowler shall use highest sanctioned 2023 2024 league average as of and including Sunday, March 17, 2024 with a minimum of 21 games. A copy of bowler's league sheet as of and including March 17, 2024 showing bowlers total pins and games with average must accompany the entry form. If a youth bowler does not have a 21 game average for 2023-24 they shall use their final 2022-23 average with a 21 game minimum.

Adult bowler shall use shall use their final 2022-23 average with a 21 game minimum. If a 2022-23 average is not available then the adult bowler may use their highest sanctioned 2023 • 2024 league average as of and including Sunday, March 17, 2024 with a minimum of 21 games. If using 2023-24 average, a copy of bowler's league sheet as of and including March 17, 2024 showing bowlers total pins and games with average must accompany the entry. If neither 2023-24 or 2022-23 average can be provided, or if adult bowler is not certified, the bowler will enter as scratch.

Any Sports average, youth or adult, will be adjusted based on the USBC scale

- 6. In case of disability/injury after a game has started, unfinished frames/games will be scored with a zero.
- 7. Pre-Paid late bowlers will be allowed to bowl but starting at the current frame and receiving zero for the frames missed.
- 8. Walk ins permitted as space allows and must check in no later than 30 minutes prior to squad time.
- 9. Only competitors and tournament officials shall be allowed in the settee area during practice and competition. No coaching of bowlers will be allowed during tournament competition.
- 10. Bowlers are not permitted to eat or drink in the player's area while participating in the tournament. There will be no alcoholic beverages consumed at or behind the lanes during the competition.
- 11. The use of any electronic device in the bowler's area is prohibited during competition.
- 12. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament manager immediately. All score corrections must be made or approved by a tournament official.
- 13. Any appeal or protest shall, in all cases, be made in writing to the tournament manager and shall be submitted no later than 24 hours after the game has been bowled. Entrants must state grounds for the appeal or protest and all pertinent information. The action of the tournament officials shall be final.
- 14. Scholarships will be awarded on a 1:3 ratio in each division to the youth bowlers only

## DRESS CODE (STRICTLY ENFORCED):

All entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use good judgement when selecting attire. worn tattered or faded clothing is not considered suitable. Longer length dress shorts may be worn. No jean shorts or short shorts.

The following attire is PROHIBITED: Hats, CLOTHING ADVERTISING TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, OBSCENE GESTURES OR OBSCENE PICTURES IS PROHIBITED. Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament manager or designee. Decisions will be final. Questions about appropriate attire may be directed to the SWC Office or tournament management on site.
